## Attachment: 8 - Objects or Purpose of the Co-operative

Within the context of the Co-operative Principles and Values, the objectives of the Co-operative shall be:

- a) To provide goods and services to the general public and to members in the Killick Coast North region (as prescribed by the board) helping them age well at home and in their communities;
- b) To help overcome loneliness and isolation through building a sense of community and through co-creating a jointly-owned and democratically-controlled social enterprise within a framework of gender equity, diversity, inclusion, belonging, and anti-racism;
- c) To provide related goods and services to members and the general public: the services are provided mainly by members and volunteers; they may include social and educational activities and services as well as support with transportation, light work in and out of the house, technology, and through vetted access to vendor services; and they may be provided based on a tiered fee structure as prescribed by the board;
- d) To conduct educational work among its members and volunteers in order to attain the above objectives; and
- e) To engage in any and all other acts which may assist in the success of the Co-operative and its members and, in the attainment of all the preceding objects, provided such acts are in accordance with co-operative principles, the Co-operative Act, these by-laws and policies and procedures of the Co-operative.
